## FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)



The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is federal legislation governing access to, amendment of and disclosure of student education records. FERPA provides that education records cannot be disclosed without the student's written consent. However, federal law permits Doane University to notify parents of students under the age of 21 of the student's alcohol violations.

Education records means those records directly related to the student and maintained by Doane University and include but are not limited to, academic, disciplinary, personal, financial and extracurricular records. In order for school officials to discuss your education records with parents or any other non-school official, you must complete, sign and date the **Consent to Release.**
